

Parasite Dust - powder

The compound is formulated from *Azadirachta indica*, *Achillea millefolium* and diatom flour.

The manner of application which has yielded success is to start at the base of the tail running your hand against the direction that the hair grows sprinkling the dust along the spine and making sure the dust is in contact with the skin. This should be done under dry conditions. One to two ounces is enough to dust a large herbivore (e.g. a horse). The dust should cover the saddle to midlateral.

The ingredients singly are nonmutagenic and nontoxic to mammals, fish and birds. It is expected that in compound they also are harmless in the form and concentration in this product.
